### The Valuable Work and Need of Mobilization

When considering world missions and evangelization, there are various roles in which Christians can be involved. They include being a learner and getting educated about mission efforts around the world, praying for the lost and for God to send more 'laborers into the harvest', going out as a called and trained believer to share the love of Jesus, equipping and sending called individuals to the nations to preach the truth of Christ, welcoming and receiving both mission workers returning from overseas and the diaspora peoples who have migrated around the

world, and lastly mobilizing fellow Christians to take up the great commission call where they are and get involved.

Each disciple of Jesus are not just Christians, but 'Global Christians'. This Christian is known by their love for God while also adopting God's heart for the world and the lost. The result of thinking globally will cause a person to

change their views on many things including their possessions, relationships, ambitions, successes, what is Biblical vs what is merely cultural, choosing a major in college, vocation, wealth, security, refugees, use of time, retirement, and many more. Our minds literally are transformed by the renewing power of the Holy Spirit.

One role I want to highlight is the role of the mobilizer. Many people may be unfamiliar with who mobilizers are and what they do. Mobilizers help cast the Gospel vision helping the global church get educated, equipped, and mobilized in various roles to fulfill the work of building up God's kingdom. Mobilizers can be just as vitally important as the goers (the missionaries themselves) in the global mission effort in that mobilizers help recruit, educate, empower, develop, and coach going cross-cultural mission workers. Mobilizers are crucial on informing the church body about the great need for gospel bearers and then sending those called people out to where God is leading them.

The exciting news of mobilization is that every follower of Jesus can be a mobilizer in a different way. Whether you mobilize people to Christ, mobilize people to church, or mobilize to the mission field, all work together towards fulfilling the Great Commission. Mobilization is a key in global mission.






