2021 Mentorship Online Conference

During three Saturdays In October, 2021, Second Level hosted the Mentorship Conference online. This conference was geared to train Japanese disciple makers and aimed to equip each participant to put what they have learned into practice in their own churches and personal ministries.

We are thankful for this wonderful opportunity that 60 Japanese believers were able to gather and learn about discipleship. We were excited to have a special group for pastors. Following the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20), we provided Japanese believers with discipleship opportunities, training, resources, community, and encouragement for spiritual growth.

Under the theme of 'Discovery', the program was focused on discovering about ourselves, God's will, and how to serve others. Our speaker, Rev. Toyoda (New Life Christian Church) gave us three messages that touched on critical issues of Christian identity and God's desire for us to serve for one another. Rev. Toyoda encouraged us to accept ourselves in His gaze and surrender ourselves out of love for God, so that we can love others with His love. All of our journeys to discover our true identity in Christ continues. Many attendees expressed that this conference exceeded their expectations, and more than anything, they were touched by what God taught them. Out of this conference, have many people who started accountability partners, or IBS (Inductive Bible Study) that we introduced as a discipleship tool.

Attendees were challenged in each session. In Rev. Ueda's session, they learned the importance of quieting our spirit so that we can hear God better. Being in God's presence also helps us to be honest with ourselves, thus it brings new discoveries in our hearts. Mr. Kuge's workshop was a testimony of his discipleship journey. His experience in God's guidance brought deep encouragement and a challenge to minister to others. Mrs. Ikeda, who is the Soul Care director of Second Level Ministry, offered a lot of practical tips in relationship with others, considering some deep human needs. Attendees learned what they need to be aware of particularly in mentoring.

Inductive Bible Study

In the program called Discovery 1, "Me in Christ", we practiced how to notice emotions. We noted from the movement in our hearts, with stories and self-reflection, then examined where the emotions came from. This reflection brought deep self-discovery. In Discovery 2, "What is IBS?", we exercised how to digest God's word, utilizing IBS (Inductive Bible Study) method. IBS focuses on observation with careful examination, interpretation with a seeking heart, and application with a willingness and obedience. The program coordinators created a

video guide for IBS, so please check it out and pass it onto Japanese speakers.
